Section 2: Hazard(s) Identification

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW:

This is a personal care or cosmetic product that is safe for consumers and other users under intended and reasonably foreseeable use. Additional information on toxicological endpoints is available from the OFRA COSMETICS upon request.

POTENTIAL HEALTH EFFECTS:

Eye:
